

“The Forensic Science Centre as one of the departments under the Attorney Generals Office took part in the pilot programme for the implementation of the PRDS, and as such all our personnel, were exposed to the PRDS training and its principles.

During this period, the department commenced making recommendations for appointment, for 80% of the staff to the newly established post. Although the Centre had not fully implemented the PRDS, management was able to apply the PRDS principles in evaluating and grading the officers and this approach was invaluable to the appointment exercise. PRDS proved to be an impartial Human Resource tool to evaluating the officer performance in many areas and the Centre looks forward to the full implementation of the PRDS programme.”
